







On-line Industry Days on 16 and 25 November 2020

Are you a company exporting to or importing from the UK? Do you want to learn more about how to prepare for the end of the transition period, when the trade relationship between the EU and the UK changes?

The UK Government's Border Protocol and Delivery Group will walk you through the steps you need to take in order to prepare for the new trading regime with the UK from 1 January 2021. The focus will be on customs procedures, the import and export of goods, food, live animals, animal products and feed, and plants. It will also cover the impact on transport infrastructure around and beyond border points.

There are two planned events available to join:

On 16 November 2020 from 11.00 to 13.00 CET, this "Industry Day" is organised by the UK's Department for International Trade for the Central and Eastern Europe. It will contain a general overview, relevant to businesses in countries across the region.

On 25 November 2020 from 9.00 to 13.00 CET (postponed from 3 November), organised by the British Embassy in Prague, this "Industry Day" will be similar to the event on 16 November, but will also cover case studies which are specific to the Czech market, which may also be relevant for Slovak businesses.

The Embassy is working to arrange English/Czech simultaneous interpretation, but cannot yet guarantee the event will be interpreted. We will confirm closer to the event date.

A final programme for both events will be circulated closer to the event date.
